LUNCH: The Rockettown Lunch Special will feature fruit, chips and desert daily along with: corn dogs on Mondays, cheese burgers on Tuesdays, chicken sandwiches on Wednesdays and pizza on Thursdays. The Rockettown Coffee Bar will also have burgers, hot dogs, drinks and additional lunch food available for purchase daily.

PRE & POST CARE: Pre-Care will allow individuals to arrive early, be supervised and take part in morning games, hangout with Rockettown staff and watch TV. After-Care will allow individuals to take part in academic, life skills and recreational activities. Possible activities include mixed media art, blogging, build stuff and African drumming.

ELECTIVES: In the afternoon, from 1-3 pm, individuals will participate in an elective of their choice. Youth will sign-up for these electives every Monday of Summer Sessions. Choices will change each week, but past options have included: skateboarding, beat making, dance, screen printing, photography, drums, guitar, film editing and more.

LOCATION: Programs will take place primarily inside Rockettown. Occasionally, youth will walk with instructors to the park or downtown for supervised activities.

BELONGINGS: Each individual is responsible for his or her own belongings.

SHOWCASE: At the end of each week, individuals will display accomplishments and final projects in a showcase on Thursday from 2-3 pm. All family and friends are invited.
